

# Coat of Arms Defined

The representation as set into the design of the Coat of Arms and banner of the Knights of the Pub Table;

- The Blue Mantling represents military service which brought most of us together
- The Silver Lineing represents the steel of our loved ones who have missed us from afar
- The Helm represents all Knights of the Pub Table
- The Shield represents the Pub Table
- The Green and Red Division (Gyronny of 8) represents the standard eight seats of the Pub Table, and the Lords, and Ladies who have graced it
- The Castle and Dragon Charges represent the game of choice, Dungeons and Dragons which brought the First Table together
- The Chalice Charge (which is larger than the other Charges) represents all of our Family and Friends of old, who are not with us, and those yet to grace our Table and share a drink in the Pub, the Chalice is of a golden metal hue signifying our acceptance of all, and the value and love of the character of each individual
- Finally the Banner below the Shield has the Knights Voted Motto in a Latin inscription “Gloriam Mensa, Bibe, et Talis” which is “Honor the Table, Drink, and Dice” on a background tone similar to parchment symbolizing traditions that we hold dear and those that we will make.
